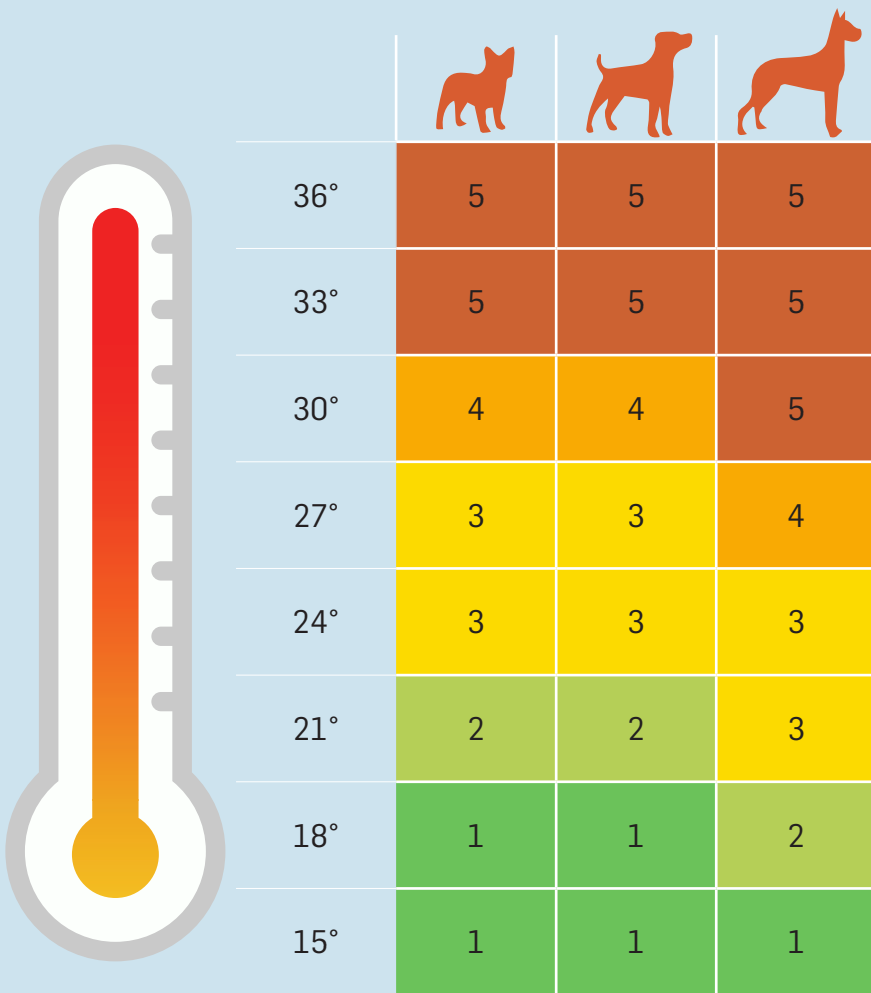


How hot is too hot?



+1 if obese

+1 if brachycephalic breed

+1 if less than 6 months old or elderly

-1 if area is shaded from sun

-1 if water is available

No evidence of risk: Have fun outside!

2

Risk is unlikely: Have fun outside, but be careful!

3

Unsafe potential, depending on breed. Keep an eye on your pet outdoors.

4

Dangerous weather developing. Use caution.

5

Potentially life-threatening heat. Avoid prolonged outdoor activity.

The closer the temp of the day is to your pet's body temperature, the harder it is for them to keep themselves cool.



Never, ever leave a dog alone in a car. Even in the shade, the temperature in the car can still soar quickly to dangerous levels. Leaving the windows open has little effect on how hot it is inside the car.



Make sure your vehicle is well ventilated when you're on a car journey together.
